ONE MINUTE SILENCE AS A MARK OF RESPECT FOR THOMAS WRIGHT

All persons present stood in silence as a mark of respect for Drummer Thomas Wright of Ripley who had been killed in an explosion in Afghanistan on 24 June 2007 whilst serving with the Worcestershire and Sherwood Foresters Regiment. The Town Clerk was to send a letter of condolence to his parents on behalf of the Township of Ripley.

4872 MINUTES – PLANNING SUB-COMMITTEE – 8 JUNE AND 15 JUNE 2007

It was reported that since the consideration of Planning Application AVA/2007/0615 (Minute 15/07 - Planning Sub Committee – 8 June 2007) – Proposed 12 residential units (approval of reserved matters) land at Kirk Close, Ripley for William Davis Homes by John Sutherland Partnership 40 High Pavement Lace Market Nottingham it had been brought to the Town Council's attention that the very important tarmaced and lit footpath link between Kirk Close and Maple Avenue was not to be retained. This path is a well used path for residents to walk to the Leisure Centre, the Town Centre and seeking access to the bus services along Derby Road as well as the only recreation ground serving the Elms Estate (since the closure of Cedar Avenue). It was considered that for those reasons the strongest possible additional objections should be made to the Borough Council.

4877 PARISH COUNCIL ELECTIONS 2007 - BRIEFING MEETING AND COUNT

It was reported that the Returning Officer had reported that the Briefing Meeting had been organised by the Borough Council when the venue was available and to allow candidates the evening free for canvassing electors and community events. The impact of postal votes had to be taken into consideration. The new postal votes procedure was not complete until 1.30 am which was considered too late to commence counting of the votes. Now the recognition software had been tested it was anticipated that a return to a same day count would be possible. The Returning Officer apologised for the difficulty caused by the building work at Alfreton Leisure Centre but considered that there were simply no other alternative premises available. In respect of the Election results they had been posted on the Town Hall Notice Boards as soon as possible after the election.

Members expressed their dissatisfaction with the Returning Officers response and raised a further issue in respect of the Sainsburys Polling Station venue which was considered too far away for residents who had to walk and the necessity to cross a very busy road to the Polling Station. Members asked for the Polling Station to return to St John's School Dannah Street

4891 BRITISH FORCES FREE POSTAGE PETITION (MINUTE 4856)

It was reported that the Ministry of Defence in acknowledging the Council's representations had pointed out that the Tewkesbury Borough Council motion was factually incorrect. The British Forces have never had a free parcel service. The Royal Mail Group had operated as a goodwill gesture a "free service" unique to Iraq at a time when welfare services were not available. The premise of the military postal service was that Service Personnel and their families should not be disadvantaged by service overseas. Any postage level equates to the UK inland rate regardless of the overseas location. The service subsidy is only part of the welfare services at the disposal of service personnel which includes free telephone calls access to radio, TV, DVD players and video gamed machines and internet services.

4900 ADVANCE WARNING OF ROAD CLOSURE – B6179 BUTTERLEY HILL RIPLEY

It was reported that significant drainage works by the housing developer on the Butterley Works site had applied to the County Council for a road closure on the B6179 Butterley Hill; from the junction with the Coach Road to the junction with Butterley Lane for the period 31 July – 24 August 2007. The diversionary route would be between the A38 Watchorn Island at Alfreton and Hartshay Hill Interchange at the A610 Ripley.

Great concern was expressed in relation to local traffic trying to utilise residential routes to accommodate the closure and the drastic effect the closure could have on the public transport services and tourist attractions like the Midland Railway.
